

The final will be available on-line on Friday, August 14, from 10:00 am till 10:00 pm. You will have two hours (120 minutes) to complete it.

The final will be comprehensive; that is, it will cover all 27 lectures and the readings for the course, but more questions will be drawn from the material covered since the midterm (Lectures 12-27).

It will be open book, meaning that you can use lecture notes, handouts, textbooks, etc. during the exam. This does NOT mean that you do not need to study the material in advance, as the test will be time constrained.

The test will consist of 12 essay questions, with point values of 4, 5, 8 or 10 points each for a total of 70 points.. Higher point questions required more complete or more complex answers; you should be sure not to spend too much time on the initial lower point questions so as to have plenty of time for the longer ones later in the test.

Questions from the weekly quizzes may reappear on the final. You should be sure that you know the correct answer to all quiz questions asked during the course of the semester.
