near Shrinigar, Kashmir, India; 17th c.; patrons, Emperors Jahangir and Jehan

Nishat Bagh

near Shrinigar, Kashmir, India; 17th c.; patron, Vizir Asaf Khan

Piccolomini Palace garden

Pienza, IT; 1460-62; Rossolino; patron, Pope Pius II (Piccolomini)

Villa Lante

Bagnia, IT; begun 1568; Vignola (?); patron Cardinal Gianfrancesco Gambara

Villa d'Este

Tivoli, IT; begun 1561; Pirro Legorio; patron, Cardinal Ippolito d'Este

Redesign of Villa Farnese

Caprarola, IT; 1570's; Vignola; patron, Cardinal Alessandro Farnese

The Barchetto

on grounds of Villa Farnese at Caprarola; 1584-1620; Giacomo del Duca and Girolamo Rainaldi; patron, Cardinal Alessandro Farnese
